Château Tour Sivadon was born from the marriage of the Château La Tour (1848) and Château Sivadon (1907). Located in the commune of Les Lèves et Thoumeyragues, not far from Sainte Foy la Grande, this estate has been in the same family for generations.

From father to son, the COUSINETs have worked their land and their vineyard hand in hand, all the while continuing to preserve and develop the heritage of their wines.

### Vinification

Made in the pure tradition of the Bordeaux chateaux: gentle extraction to obtain the best juice. Aging in stainless steel tank before bottling and storage for 6 months with a perfect temperature control.

**Nose |** Fruity and highly aromatic, revealing notes of jammy fruit. Palate | Beautiful attack, supple and round with lovely tannins and structure. Beautiful expression of fruit. Aromas of ripe, jammy fruit enhanced by hints of caramel.
